RE: Best Practice Submission, "Peri-Urban Upgrading Programme in Angola"

I have the pleasure to inform you that the above-mentioned initiative has been selected by the Technical Advisory Committee as one of the 40 Best Practices to be forwarded to the Jury which will meet on 28-29 March 1996 in Toronto, Canada. The Jury will ultimately select 10 or 12 of the forty to be given special recognition at the City Summit in Istanbul at a special award ceremony tentatively scheduled for 4 June 1996.

The Award will include a special plaque, a scroll as well as a grant. The grant can be used to cover the costs of one or more of the following:

- Travel and per diem for two people directly involved in the Best Practice
- Cost of producing a video film not exceeding 10 minutes.

We are informing you of the fact that you have been placed on the short list so that your organisation will, in the event that it is chosen by the Jury, be prepared:

- a) To have 2 representatives directly involved in the best practice travel to Istanbul to attend the award ceremony;
- b) To prepare a 10 minute video-film, if you have not already made one, to be part of the Best Practice Video Festival in Istanbul;
- c) To participate in the Best Practices exhibition in Istanbul which is open to all Best Practices submittals (see attached survey sheet).


